Dear Parents/Caregivers

Incredibly the penultimate week of the school year!

Thank you to all people who took the opportunity to meet with me to discuss placement of our students in Base Groups for 2016. I am pleased that in 100% of cases we were able to meet parent requests. Apart from new students to our school the Base Groups will remain as they are now. It has been a delight to see the excitement of students with their placements and their anticipation of being with a wider group for teaching and learning.

Along with the Board of Proprietors, our School Management Team is reviewing a more transparent model for payments in 2016. There are some costs such as Attendance Dues which are compulsory and for Year 7 and 8 students the Technology fee for the materials used for products taken home (sometimes this is food eaten soon after being made). Some other levies are voluntary donations. Some on and off site activities incur costs such as outdoor education, cultural visits, sports competitions and international academic competitions will be on a user pays basis. This is inherently fair and reflective of our society and enables all to be accountable for each child's expenses.

We welcome you and any other supporters of our school to our Prizegiving on Tuesday 15 December from 7pm. We would appreciate the children being there by 6.45pm for organisational purposes. Please consider that parking nearby may be limited. Please have students dressed in formal uniform for this significant occasion.
