We did a Surf to School beach mufti day to help people from Indonesia have clean drinking water. The mufti day is part of Waves for Water, Surf to School program.

People brought a money donation and we will send all the money to Winter Vincent. He gets all of the water filters which cost \$50.00. Then he gives them to villages in Indonesia and shows them how to use them.

The reason why we wore our beach clothes is because Indonesia is very hot.

We raised \$314NZD, which will support 6 water filters and help a lot of people in villages in Indonesia. Winter has a goal of \$50,000 to be raised. So far \$43,386 has been raised and our St Marks donation will add to this. So far 21,693 people have been impacted.


