Kia ora St Mark's whānau,

Week 7 and this week sees the whole school involved in Māori weaving - raranga. You may have seen evidence of this on our Facebook page where students and staff have been working on making flax ropes/taura and flax bowls/kono. Learning about the tikanga around harvesting the flax/harakeke and weaving/raranga was a significant part of the learning. This mahi/work resonated with the narrative of Moana, and our growing Aotearoa New Zealand Histories Curriculum. We were so fortunate to have Sonia Lucchese with us and that this was funded through the Kahui Ako and an extension of the Teacher Only Day that started our term. We encourage you to talk about these sessions with your child. Mrs Elliott and Mrs Fairchild will join staff tomorrow ensuring all staff are part of this learning.

Playground

Great progress has been made on our new senior playground in the last few weeks. It is exciting to see features taking shape. Grass will be sown on various parts of the playground this week and various pieces of the original equipment will be completed. Whilst we don't have a timeframe on the completion of the project we are thrilled with the progress. It is really important to note that the original climbing equipment has been repurposed and the grey "future posts" around the gaga pit and rebound wall are recycled domestic and commercial waste plastic. Needless to say the inextricable links to our school five marks of mission are evident and to be celebrated. It will be a playscape for all.
